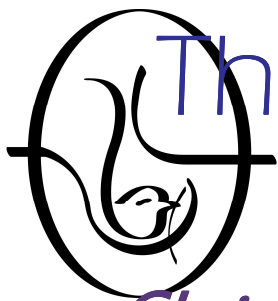
SCHEDULE AND PROGRAM: The program will begin at 2:00 pm on Tuesday, June 5 and end at noon on Thursday, June 7. A plenary presentation by each speaker will be followed by small and large group dialogue. *An exciting additional feature* this year is our workshop program. The workshops will be run by individuals and groups developing theological practice out of mimetic anthropology. PRE-CONFERENCE MIMETIC THEORY OVERVIEW: A free-of-charge pre-conference program is offered from 9:30 am to 12:30 pm on Tuesday, June 5th, providing an immersion in Mimetic Theory, the anthropological understanding at the heart of Theology and Peace. Includes free continental breakfast (lunch available for purchase at the college). For those traveling from distance and attending this program there is accommodation at the college on Monday night.
